



Iran strikes US bases amid Hormuz tensions

Iran has carried out strikes on US military bases in Kuwait and Bahrain in response to recent American military operations. According to US military sources, Tehran fired seven ballistic missiles in the attack, as reported by Al Jazeera.

Earlier, US Central Command (CENTCOM) said it intercepted several Iranian drones heading toward the Strait of Hormuz and also claimed strikes on Iranian radar sites.

CENTCOM stated that six of the seven missiles were destroyed by defence systems, while the remaining one failed to hit its target.

The US military confirmed that no American casualties were reported and denied Iran's claim of damage to the US Fifth Fleet headquarters in Bahrain.

A temporary ceasefire between the two countries came into effect on April 8, but diplomatic talks for a lasting agreement are still ongoing amid continued tensions.
