



Jamaat Will Join National Dialogue if BNP Takes Initiative: Hamidur Azad

Hamidur Rahman Azad, Assistant Secretary General of Jamaat-e-Islami Bangladesh, has said that dialogue could be the only way to resolve the ongoing political crisis in the country. He added that if the BNP takes the initiative for discussions, Jamaat is ready to participate in the dialogue.

Speaking to journalists on Monday (10 November) afternoon after a joint meeting of Islamic parties at Purana Paltan, he said, “The door for discussions with BNP on the nation’s future remains open. Only through mutual dialogue can a peaceful solution to the crisis be achieved.”

Hamidur Azad also mentioned that Jamaat’s rally on Tuesday will convey important messages to both the public and the government. He warned that if demands are not met, a nationwide mass movement will be organized starting from the capital.

He further stated that the rally will run from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM, keeping the duration limited to reduce public inconvenience. Hamidur Azad expressed hope, saying, “Tomorrow, millions will join our program and show that the people of the country are in favor of change.”
