



## Fakhrul urges govt to hold national election without delay



The BNP leader called for essential reforms and a clear electoral roadmap to guarantee a fair election process. BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir on Thursday urged the government to remove uncertainties surrounding the national election and hold it without delay. "We want a quick election, we want to see a stable Bangladesh," he said while speaking at a public rally in Laksam and Monohargonj upazilas of Comilla.

The BNP leader called for essential reforms and a clear electoral roadmap to guarantee a fair election process. Criticizing the Awami League, he said: "Over the past 15 years, the Awami League has undermined the integrity of the electoral system.
