



China has changed the tune to the Ukraine issue, reports Trump support

China has supported the US agreement with Russia to end the Ukraine war. Beijing clearly created their position on the issue at the G-20 conference of South Africa

Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi says Beijing has full support for any recent consensus between Washington and Moscow to ensure peace in Ukraine. China is always ready to make a constructive contribution to a fair political solution to the ongoing crisis. At a security conference held in Munich last week, Wang said that the participation of all parties concerned is essential for the end of the Ukraine-Russia war. Of course, Ukraine does not participate in the US efforts yesterday.

Trump has made his own morgue after a long-term US policy in the Ukraine-Russia issue, not a month after sitting in the Oval Office. Generally, the US presidents have accepted some of the US views followed by their predecessors, such as the election of a friend or enemy state, as Trump has taken on the mission to wash all the steps of Biden. Trump has drawn Russia, one of the most rival and long-standing Russia in the United States. Some time ago, he had a phone call on Putin on the issue of Ukraine on his own Gorge without consulting a Western friend. Meanwhile, officials of the two countries in Saudi Arabia are discussing the peace agreement by leaving Ukraine out of the field.

Analysts commented that the latest statement of the Chinese Foreign Minister was tried to stop his position in the current situation. They say China had had a kind of influence on Russia for so long, saying that diplomatically became diplomatically. They were also getting the opportunity to increase communication with European officials. But the way Trump is suddenly invited to bring Putin to the world court, it is feared that Beijing may lose their European involvement. For that reason, Beijing will try to keep themselves involved in the deal, no matter what Trump-Putin signed
