



Israeli Strike on Lebanon Health Center Kills Six

At least six people were killed and 22 others injured in an Israeli strike targeting a healthcare center and ambulance unit in the southern Lebanese town of Harouf. Among the dead were three paramedics, according to local reports. Initial casualty figures were lower, but Lebanese sources later confirmed that the death toll had risen. Panic spread across the area following the attack as rescue teams rushed the wounded to nearby hospitals. According to Al Jazeera Arabic, the airstrike caused extensive damage to the health facility. Several of the injured remain in critical condition, raising fears that the death toll could increase further.
