



Nisho Begins Work on Dom in the Mountains of Kazakhstan

Popular actor Afrán Nisho is scouting shooting locations for the film *Dom* in the remote mountains of Kazakhstan. Director Redoan Rony and producer Shahriar Shakil are also on-site with the team. The film is set to release on Eid-ul-Fitr 2026.

Afrán Nisho, one of Bangladesh's most celebrated actors, has been spotted in the rugged terrains of Kazakhstan. He was accompanied by director Redoan Rony, producer Shahriar Shakil, art director Shahidul Islam, and several other team members.

The team is reportedly conducting a recce for *Dom*, a survival-themed film scheduled for release during Eid-ul-Fitr in 2026. Director Redoan Rony shared photos on Facebook and Instagram with the caption: "Testing the breath of Dom." He also used hashtags such as #DomRecce and #Kazakhstan.

Previously, Saudi Arabia and Jordan were considered as possible shooting destinations, but Kazakhstan was finalized after location inspections. The filmmakers are evaluating what kind of scenes can be filmed in the region and the challenges involved.

Director Redoan Rony said, "We're here to give *Dom* its breath. The story is inspired by real events, focusing on survival."

The cast includes Afrán Nisho and Chanchal Chowdhury. Nisho expressed excitement, saying the role will push his performance boundaries. Chanchal added that the story is extraordinary and will surprise audiences.

However, the lead actress for the film has not yet been finalized.

Produced by SVF Alpha-i Entertainment and Chorki, *Dom* is expected to hit theaters during Eid-ul-Fitr 2026, with filming beginning soon.
