



Revolution Cannot Last Without a Strong Organization: Mirza Fakhrul

BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir has emphasized that a strong organization is essential to achieve social change or realize the dream of a revolution. He noted that the lack of strong organizational structures is the main reason for today's widespread disappointment. He made these remarks at a memorial event for the late politician and thinker Badruddin Umar on Friday (19 September).

Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir spoke as the chief guest at the memorial of Badruddin Umar, held at the Abdul Karim Sahitya Bisharad Auditorium of Bangla Academy on Friday (19 September) at 5:00 PM.

He said, "Those who want to bring about a revolution, change society, or improve the lives of ordinary people must first strengthen their organizations. No movement or revolution can succeed without a strong organization. The main cause of today's frustration is the weakness of organizational structures."

Paying tribute to Badruddin Umar, Fakhrul added, "I have been a long-time reader and admirer of his writings. I also learned about his family from my father. Until his last days, he upheld his ideals and struggles."

He further remarked, "In today's political landscape, many are far smaller compared to Badruddin Umar. He never compromised. How much the new generation has been able to learn from him remains questionable."

At the memorial, he reiterated the importance of organization, saying, "Badruddin Umar always emphasized—organization, organization, organization. Without a strong organization, a revolution cannot be sustainable."
