



Jamaat Ameer Dr. Shafiqur Rahman to Undergo Open-Heart surgery on Today Morning

Dr. Shafiqur Rahman, the Ameer of Jamaat-e-Islami, is scheduled to undergo open-heart surgery at 7:00 AM tomorrow (Saturday) at United Hospital in Dhaka. The procedure will be led by renowned cardiologist Dr. Jahangir Kabir. Following the detection of five arterial blockages, doctors opted for surgery instead of placing stents. Party leaders have called upon the public to pray for his swift recovery.

Dr. Shafiqur Rahman, the Ameer of Jamaat-e-Islami, will undergo open-heart surgery on Saturday, August 2, at 7:00 AM at United Hospital in the capital. The announcement was made by Jamaat Secretary General Mia Golam Parwar during a press briefing at the party's central office on Friday (August 1) afternoon.

The surgery will be conducted by an experienced medical team led by cardiologist Dr. Jahangir Kabir.

The party has requested prayers from well-wishers and supporters at home and abroad for Dr. Rahman's recovery.

It is noteworthy that Dr. Shafiqur Rahman suddenly fell ill during a national rally at Suhrawardy Udyan on July 19. Initially, it was thought that he had suffered heat exhaustion. However, subsequent hospital tests revealed five blockages in his heart. Although doctors initially planned angioplasty with stent placement, they later decided that open-heart surgery would be more appropriate.

The Jamaat leadership and supporters have sincerely appealed to the public for prayers for his successful surgery and full recovery.
