



Kuwait Conflict: The Investigation Committee 'It will take more time' after two points



The Investigation Committee formed in the Khulna University of Engineering and Technology (Kuwait) conflict could not submit the report even after extending the two -point period. The committee claims that the students are not being interviewed as the university is closed. As a result, they also could not report. They could not say when the report would be submitted.

The convener of the committee, Professor MMA Hashem, said, "The students are gone because the university is closed. No students on campus. It will take time. According to information received from the University Administration and Investigation Committee, the Investigation Committee was formed at a meeting of the Syndicate on February 7 for a full investigation, including finding the real culprits in the Kuwait clash on February 7.

Professor MMA Hashem, Professor of Computer Science and Engineering in Kuwait, was asked to report within three business days. The three working days scheduled for the committee ended on February 26. Then, in the interest of a fair investigation, the Investigation Committee applied with the administration to extend the period of time. The last day of that extended period was March 7. Professor Hashem said, "If the students do not interview, we cannot finalize the report. But our work is in progress. We are trying to verify the information from the partners of the incident. "

Responding to the question by when the investigation report could be given, he said, "We have already applied for" time ". Now the university is so closed. Let's see how long the authority or the syndicate gives.
