



Houthi Missile Attack Targets Israel

Yemen's Houthi rebels have launched a missile attack targeting Israel, triggering air raid sirens across Tel Aviv, areas near Jerusalem, and several regions in central Israel.

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) said its air defense systems were activated to intercept missiles fired from Yemen, adding that security forces remain on high alert while monitoring the situation.

The attack caused panic among civilians, with reports of residents rushing to shelters following the sirens, according to local media.

Tensions in the region have already been high following escalating exchanges involving Lebanon and Iran, including Israeli airstrikes and retaliatory actions.

Analysts warn that the Houthis' direct involvement could further widen and complicate the ongoing conflict in the Middle East.
