During his two-day visit to Dhaka, Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar held a courtesy meeting with BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia at her Gulshan residence on Sunday evening. The discussions focused on bilateral relations and Khaleda Zia's health condition.

Ishaq Dar was accompanied by Pakistan's High Commissioner to Dhaka, Imran Haider. From the BNP side, Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir, Standing Committee member Dr. AZM Zahid Hossain, and Khaleda Zia's personal assistant ABM Abdus Sattar attended the meeting.
