



Israeli Airstrikes in Lebanon Kill 16

Israel has carried out a new wave of airstrikes across several areas in Lebanon. At least 16 people were killed in the attacks on Wednesday (June 10), according to the country's Public Security and Ministry of Health.

Official reports say the coastal city of Tyre in southern Lebanon and surrounding areas were hit in multiple rounds of strikes. Several structures were damaged, resulting in casualties.

Local sources claim that civilian infrastructure was also affected. In one strike in Tyre city, at least three people were killed and several others injured.

In addition, separate attacks in eastern Tyre and villages including Dair Debba reportedly killed at least nine more people, including women and children. Rescue teams said more people may still be trapped under the rubble.

Since renewed clashes between Hezbollah and Israel began in March, the death toll in Lebanon has reached into the thousands. Attacks and counterattacks continue across various parts of the country.
