



## Remittance Inflows Reach \$1.07 Billion in First 12 Days of July

Bangladesh received about \$1.07 billion in remittance in the first 12 days of July, according to Bangladesh Bank. That means the country got around \$89.25 million every day from Bangladeshis living and working abroad.

This is more than the same time last year, when remittance was \$948 million in the first 12 days of July.

In June 2025, the total remittance Bangladesh received was \$2.82 billion.

Economists say this increase in remittance is good for the country's economy and helps keep foreign currency reserves strong
