



Shubman Gill Ton, Shami Completes 200 And Pakistan Fined – February 20 Cricket Highlights



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Team India flogged Bangladesh by six wickets in their opening Group A match of the 2025 ICC Champions Trophy in Dubai. Indian fast bowler Mohammed Shami (5-53), Harshit Rana (3-31) and Axar Patel (2-43) collectively picked up all 10 Bangladeshi wickets to fold them up for just 228 in 49.4 overs. For Bangladesh, Towhid Hridoy top-scored with 100 runs from 118 balls while Jaker Ali listed a cautious 68.

Mohammed Shami picked up figures of 5-53 against Bangladesh in match number two of the 2025 ICC Champions Trophy. Through the course of his match-winning spell, the speedster also completed 200 wickets in ODIs, becoming the joint-second fastest bowler in history to reach the landmark figure,

against New Zealand. The cricketer also confirmed the development by taking to X on February 20. The PCB has now announced Imam-ul-Haq as Fakhar’s replacement. The Pakistan team is slated to face arch-rivals Team India at the Dubai International Stadium in a must-win game on February 23.
