



Death Toll from Devastating Floods in Nepal Rises to 903

The death toll from last week's devastating floods and landslides in Nepal has risen to 903, the country's disaster management authorities have said. At the same time, 4,247 people remain unaccounted for. According to the latest figures released on Monday (August 31), rescue operations have continued in the aftermath of the disaster. So far, 10,451 people have been rescued and brought to safety. The information was provided by Nepal's National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority (NDRRMA). Widespread damage has been reported across different parts of the country following the devastating floods and landslides. Emergency rescue workers are continuing their efforts to locate the missing and carry out rescue operations in the affected areas.
