



Roadmap for the 13th National Election to Be Announced Tomorrow: EC Secretary

The Election Commission will announce the action plan (roadmap) for the 13th National Parliamentary Election tomorrow, Thursday. All preparations of the Commission have been finalized, and only the formal announcement remains.

Election Commission Secretary Akhter Ahmed confirmed that the roadmap will be unveiled tomorrow. He shared this information during a media briefing at the Election Commission's Media Center in Agargaon, Dhaka, on Wednesday (August 27).

In response to a question from journalists, the Secretary said, "The roadmap we have prepared will be announced tomorrow. There has been a slight delay as I was outside Dhaka. It is already on my table, so please wait until tomorrow."

Meanwhile, under the chairmanship of Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) A.M.M. Nasir Uddin, a meeting was held today with the participation of four commissioners and the secretary, where the roadmap for the election was approved. EC officials stated that after approval, only the typing remains, and the roadmap may be formally announced at any moment.

As part of the election preparations, the roadmap already includes issues such as party registration, delimitation of constituencies, appointment of election observers, reforms to the Representation of the People Order (RPO), issuance of rules and policies, IT-supported registration and postal ballot facilities for expatriates, as well as the procurement of electoral materials and other related matters.
